Abortion is illegal in Ireland due to the 8th Amendment in the Irish Constitution. Irish people are denied safe and legal access to abortion. As a result 12 women per day travel to the UK to exercise a UN-recognised human right. The Strike For Repeal is a direct action that will take place on the 8th March 2017.
