I'm Shiv, a second year Classicist and your current Entz Prez. Over the last year I've thoroughly enjoyed the role and now believe that my experience on the JCR Committee and passion for college life would help me do a great job if elected JCR President. During my time as Entz Prez I delivered on my promises – Bridge tickets were made available once again, the Pub Quiz was revived, Bops were packed out and we had an action packed Freshers' Week. I've had experience managing a large budget in Freshers' week, dealing with external organisations, developing relationships with key members of the college staff and been part of key meetings on JCR and squash court renovation. Here are some of the things that I'd like to change around college:

- The **Vac Res** system still needs improving and college need to see us as their main priority! Students should not have to apply for rooms when they have 9<sup>th</sup> week exams, nor should they have to leave the room they have been occupying all year when they are staying before term starts or after term ends.
- The current situation with the roles of **Chaplain and Dean of Welfare** being combined must change
- **JCR expenditure** should be publicised more clearly and more transparent. To do this I would circulate the accounts along with the meeting minutes fortnightly
- Continue discussion with **suspended students** to improve their time whilst they are away from college, whether that be increased visits to college or library use
- Corpus should commit to the **Living Wage Foundation Scheme**
- **Circuit laundry** should be replaced – machines that allowed you to set specific times would be vastly more eco-friendly and more convenient for use
- The **DO should no longer be responsible for emailing the daily menu** – it would be much more efficient for the manciple to circulate it and reduce to DO workload
- We should be able to **take books out of the library 24 hours a day** – other colleges with 24-hour libraries have automated systems
- **Storage for domestic students** at affordable pricing – this is something that I have discussed with the Domestic Bursar before, and given other colleges have this option it is very feasible
- Everyone always has their opinions on **how formal should be run**, and how often it should be held! I would encourage the DO to conduct a comprehensive survey and see what changes are desired
- Increased **support for Oxford SU campaigns** such as Class Act.
- Each student should be given a **budget to spend on printing**, perhaps a few pounds, after which then we would be charged
- I would encourage the Treasurer to **increase the budget for JCR tea** to allow for more biscuits and perhaps cake once a week.
- I would liaise with the Accommodation Officer to urge college to consider more carefully the **room allocation to freshers** – Magpie 7 should be a more welcoming environment for freshers
